- I wonder whether the catastrophic loss model is what informs Gunther Thallinger's concerns re 3 degrees warming and global reinsurance collapse
- While there is work occurring to understand cost pressures on insurance affordability for households there needs to also be work done to ensure that insurance is affordable and accessible for ALL types of community based / NFP organisations as without them the level of community resilience is deeply affected. NFP insurance premiums for community organisations of all types are being priced out meaning they are either being forced to close doors due to the cost, reduce coverage resulting in under insurance and associated issues, or are under significant financial strain when they need to fundraise to cover increasing costs which is incredibly hard when avenues to fundraise are under pressure from all fronts.

- Funding from other Ministries and programs needs to be risk-informed these resources will far exceed any funding that NEMA can muster, and will do more to achieve resilience.
