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



Spontaneous Volunteers – problem or opportunity?






Coordinated more than 1500 volunteers over 3 weeks




Targeted coordination of skilled volunteers. electricians, plumbers, mould removal






New volunteer registrations dropped off completely after about two weeks.



Lismore City, Flood Footprint, 2017



Door-knocked 1400 residences; made contact with 740 and conducted a needs analysis, identified 150 people requiring additional emotional support.

Coordinated chaplaincy visits, followup phone calls, referrals to services, and distributed non-perishable food packages and cooked meals.







750 Volunteers in one day from the Church of Christ, bussed in from across NSW, VIC & QLD.

Finished most outstanding jobs




974 requests for assistance from residents and businesses
